- Engage in authentic and meaningful conversations about the quality of adolescent health care services in Wisconsin;
- Explore misunderstandings and missed opportunities for prevention and health promotion in adolescent health services; and
- Enhance adolescent health by fostering awareness and activism.

# Symposium Learning Objectives

By participating in the Symposium, attendees will be able to:

- Describe the concerns, preferences, and realities of young people in health care settings.
- Acknowledge diversity among teens and recognize the challenges and opportunities this poses in health care settings.
- Identify clinical education, practice improvement, and policy opportunities to enhance adolescent health services in Wisconsin.
- Demonstrate ways to be adolescent health champions in their communities.

- Use best evidence and ensure the integrity of the session's content on a pertinent adolescent health topic relevant to Wisconsin communities.
- Collaborate, consult, and present with a young person integrating their voice and perspective into the session. Additional information provided below.
- Attend the entirety of the PATCH Symposium. PATCH extends one complimentary registration for the lead presenter and for one youth presenter (if applicable).
